

English placement exam “How it Works”

Before the exam takes place, you will be required to show valid Photo-ID.

This exam is reserved only for students who intend to enroll in the master's degree program in Sustainable Food Systems. A certificate of good working knowledge is mandatory to enroll in this study program (B2 in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages - e.g. TOEFL, First Cambridge Certificate, Proficiency in English, IELTS or equivalent).

NOTE that if you already hold a B2 certification, you do not need to take this exam. You only need to hand in a copy of the certificate at the time of matriculation.

If you reside outside Campania Region, you can apply to take the exam online. Your residence will be checked before the exam takes place.

How it works:

It will be a (closed book) written test (paper and pencil) of about one hour for B2 English level. Exams will be graded right after the test ends. In case it is necessary (depending upon the grade received), short interview will be added after the exam. Those who fail will be able to retake the exam at the end of October with the option of taking an online course (provided on Teams). The course will include face-to-face lectures and homeworks. For those who are eligible to do the exam online, and that require to do so, the exam will take place on a dedicated Teams channel. It will be an online written test followed by an interview.
